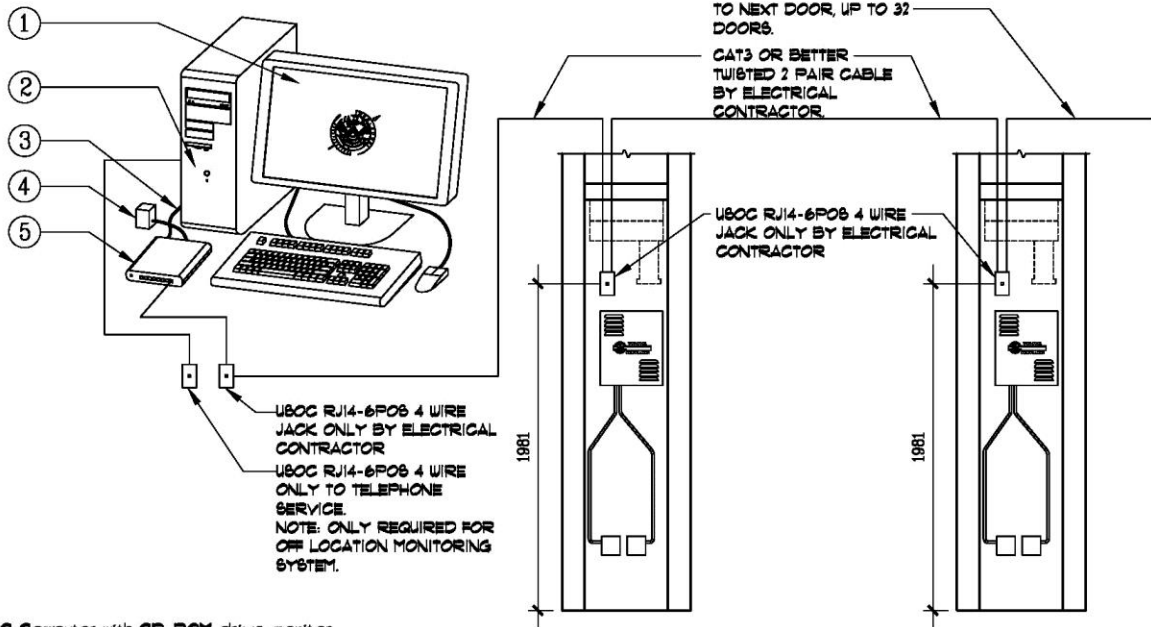


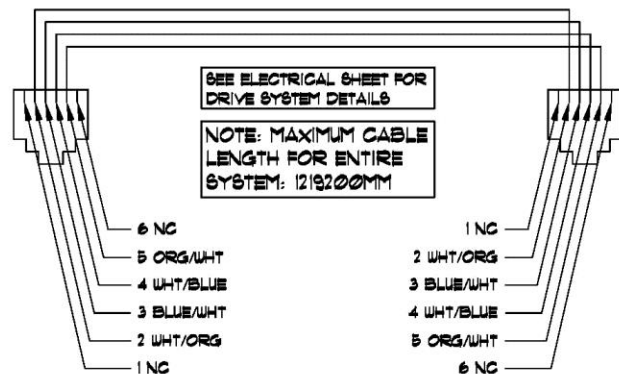
Won-Door FireGuard

ASL – ADVANCED SYNCHRONIZED LOGISTICS



1. PC Computer with CD-ROM drive, monitor, keyboard, mouse, serial port, WINDOWS, and modem (required for off-site monitoring) by others.
2. Advanced Synchronized Locking (ASL) software by Won-Door.
3. Serial cable from multi-port on-site monitor to PC by Won-Door.
4. Power supply by Won-Door.
5. Multi-port On-site Monitor box by Won-Door.

Specifier's Note

The PC-based remote display provides central control and monitoring capabilities for up to 120 fire doors. The display screen monitors current status of each door (closed, closing, open, opening, stopped, blocked, access using fire exit hardware, or locked), battery voltage, and AC line voltage. The remotely located PC allows all monitored Won-Door FireGuard doors to be opened or closed from a central control station. Doors equipped with optional magnetic locks may also be remotely locked or unlocked. Changes in door status are displayed on the monitor when doors are in fire mode or a malfunction is detected. The Remote control and Status Display Station is a dedicated PC for use with Won-Door FireGuard assemblies only.
